

Public Notice of Tariff Changes

Jackson County Water Utility, Inc. is providing notice to all customers that on August 4, 2020, it initiated a request with the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (IURC) to change certain existing tariff provisions under the IURC's 30 day filing process. This request will not increase the Company's current rates or charges; but will eliminate one charge. The request proposes to eliminate language of Section e of the Company's tariff that deals with the option of establishing installment payments for tap fees for new customers. The request proposes the elimination of language in Section h and Paragraph XI G which permit the Company to charge rural customers for changes in customers billing information. Finally the request seeks to eliminate language in Section j which implies that customers could pay a serviceman for any outstanding balance if the serviceman arrives at the customer's premises for purposes of disconnecting water service. The Company believes that any arrangements for making payments of outstanding balances should be done through the Company's office.

All of the above changes will be reviewed by the IURC over the next 30 days and may be put into place thereafter. The Company believes that these changes will not be put into place before September 10, 2020.
